

2025 Miss Teen Buffalo Rodeo Contest Rules and Regulations

- 1. The contest is open to contestants 14 to 17 years of age by January 1 of the current year.
- 2. Must be a legal resident of the state of Minnesota for at least 6 months.
- Contestants CANNOT be married, never have been married, had a marriage annulled or have a child. Should this occur during a contestant's reign, she must forfeit the title and return all prizes.
- 4. Each contestant is responsible for the conduct of HERSELF and of her PARENTS/HELPERS. If these people cause any disturbance (abusive speech or comments, or physical altercation) the contestant may be disqualified.
- 5. Contestant must dress in Rodeo Queen (*see below) attire for all aspects of the contest. Jeans, shirts, vests, or jackets should be worn. NO DRESSES ARE ALLOWED for any part of the contest. Vests or jackets are not expected during horsemanship.
- 6. Contestant shall observe a high standard of moral and ethical behavior, including on all social media, such as Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, etc. befitting the title and setting a good example to the public, future competitors, and as a representative of the Buffalo Rodeo.
- 7. Those who bring their own/ borrowed equine for horsemanship must provide a current negative coggins reported within the past 12 months. COGGINS WILL HAVE TO BE PRESENTED WITH ANY HORSE THAT IS BROUGHT ONTO THE GROUNDS STAYING OVERNIGHT OR NOT. These papers will be required at check-in. Any contestant not providing these papers will be automatically disqualified.
- 8. Contestant will participate at the Buffalo Rodeo as Miss Teen Rodeo. This may include participating in Grand Entry and raking for Barrel Racing slack.
- 9. Contestants may be invited and are encouraged to participate in community events.
- 10. Contestant shall not hold any other titles.

*Queen Attire Requirements

Western hat or cowboy hat, long sleeved collared western shirt, jeans with no holes, belt, western/cowboy boots.
